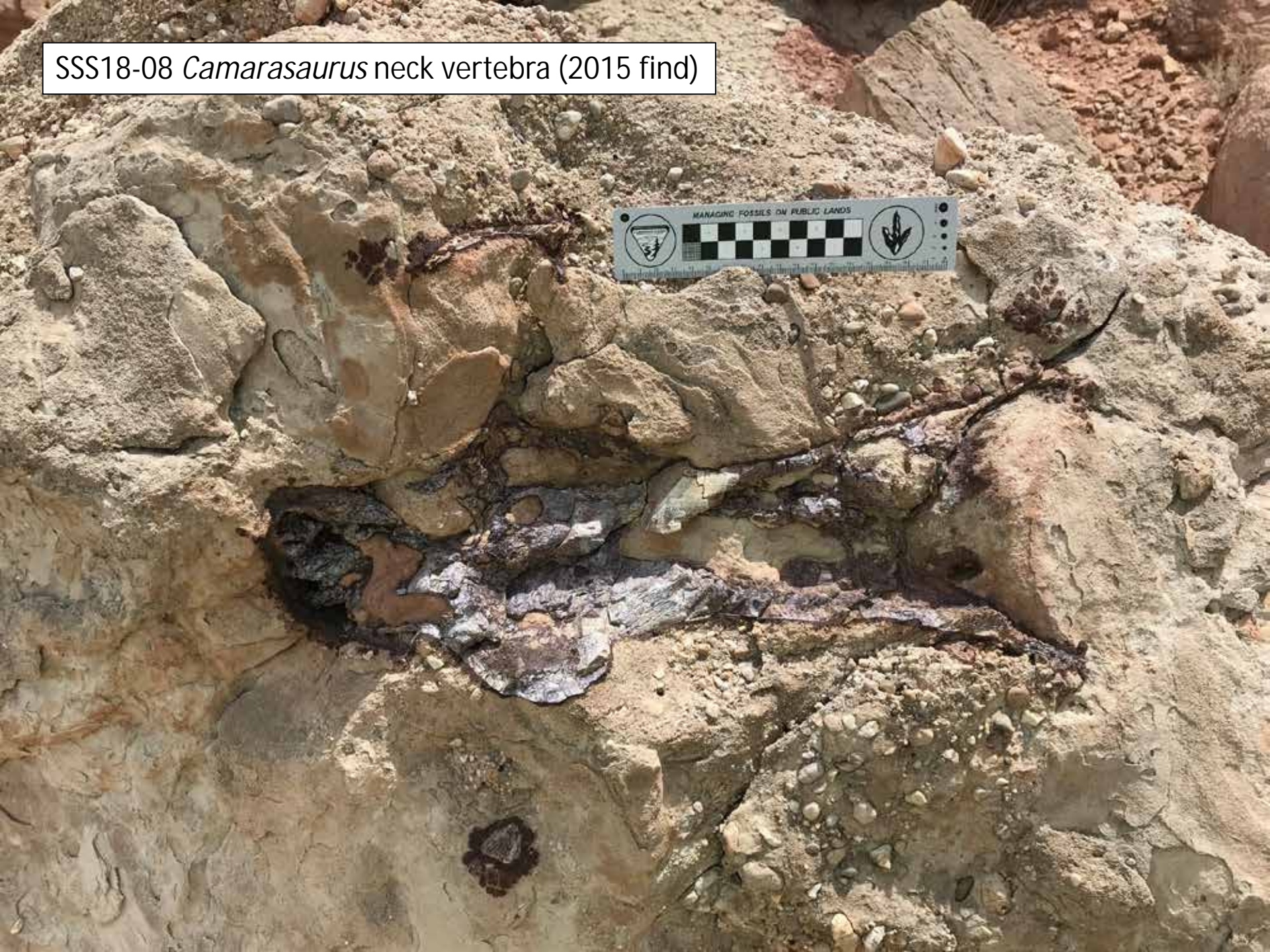


Tal Site – Representative Photos from 2018

Summary

- 62 fossil occurrences photographed, mapped, and waypointed
 - 35 new occurrences found in 2018
 - 27 occurrences discovered in 2014, 2015, and 2016 re-photographed to track erosion and other changes over time
 - Surveyed 1 mile of previously unexplored outcrop, doubling the size of the site
- 1643 photographs
